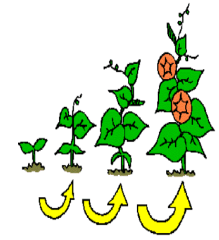

*Parents-Please remember to clock in/out only the child/children that you are dropping off or picking up.

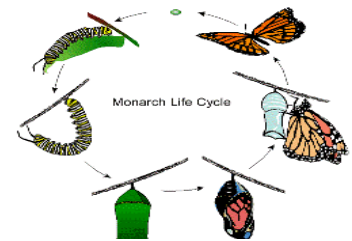
