* Graduation will be held at Silver Creek Athletic Club in the outside pavilion on **May 16th at 6:30 pm**. We will keep you updated of any changes.

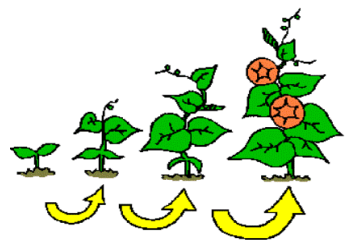
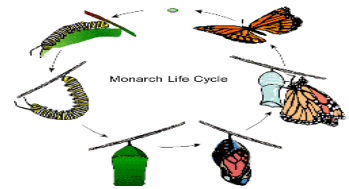
